



Part-time Lecturer Position in Electrical and/or Electronics Engineering

Position description:

In September 2016, ECAM Lyon is opening the first year of a new international program, which is an innovative five-year engineering course in Robotics or Industrial Design, **entirely taught in English** (<http://www.ecamengineering.com/study-industrial-engineering-lyon-france/>).

Upon the opening of this new program, ECAM Lyon invites applications for a part-time Lecturer position (vacataire) in Electrical and/or Electronics Engineering, to begin in September 2016.

The successful candidate will teach courses in the first year of the undergraduate program (4hr/week during Semester 1, 3hr/week during Semester 2 – total of 108h/year). The courses to be taught may include fundamentals of electricity, electromagnetism and signal processing.

This is not a tenure track position but may be renewed annually (once the 3 undergraduate years of the program are opened, a tenure position might be offered to the successful candidate, based upon criteria of excellence in classroom teaching).

Requirements:

Candidates must hold a Ph.D in a relevant field by the date of hire, or demonstrate substantial experience in teaching at university level. They must be bilingual (fluent English with significant international experience). They must possess prior experience of teaching electricity and/or electronics, and must be capable of teaching and working in a multi-cultural environment. Candidates must also demonstrate a commitment to service to the university, profession and community.

Preference will be given to those with strong international experience and background.

Salary:

Commensurate with qualifications and experience.
